Three main categories of secret messages include substitution ciphers, transposition ciphers, and concealment techniques such as using codes that replace a word with another word or with a symbol.

Substitution ciphers replace text letters with substitutes, while transposition ciphers rearrange letters to create unreadable text. Concealment techniques involve hiding messages in images or within a narrative, using invisible ink, altering colors or font.

Tips for Solving Clues:

- 1. Team Up: Collaborate with friends to spot important details others might miss.
- 2. Read Carefully: Pay close attention to clue introductions for helpful hints.
- 3. Recognize Patterns: Common ciphers often have noticeable patterns.
- 4. Study Illustrations: Look for hidden letters, numbers, oddities that don't "fit or belong", or patterns within a drawing.
- 5. Interpret Symbols: Symbols may represent familiar concepts, colors, or sequences.
- 6. Do your research spend some time online exploring common ciphers and practice teasing out solutions in puzzle books.
- 7. If you get tired or stuck, put it down and return later sleep on it. It's funny how the mind works.
- 8. Stay Positive: Enjoy the challenge!
